## HOW TO ORDER



- Log on to the Maxim website: <http://www.maxim.booklists.com.au>
- Enter the access code: REDHILL - please note this is capital sensitive.
- Select the year level required for order This is the year your child is going into for 2026.
- Enter whether you require left or right handed scissors, and if you require optional items (Years 1-6).
- If purchasing more than one booklist, please select 'Add another booklist' and follow the same procedure from step 3.
- Make Payment - please ensure your contact details and child's name are correct.
- Attend the collection day to pick up your order. If you are collecting an order on behalf of another student, please bring the order confirmation.
- Books not collected on this day will automatically be sent to classroom for your child to have on their first day of the 2026 school year.
- Orders can be placed after 31st December, 2025 - these orders will incur a \$15 late fee and will be delivered to the school throughout February.

For each Booklist collected on 22nd January, 2026 you will receive an entry into the "Booklist Prize Draw" for a chance to win either a \$100 Farrells book voucher, or a \$100 voucher to the Art Shed online store.

## VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS
