Dear families and friends,

The run of beautiful winter weather continues in Red Hill. I hope you have been enjoying the sunshine. Some of you may have seen on Class Dojo that we have two new and very woolly members of the Red Hill Consolidated School community. Mr Jarman has adopted two baby lambs, Agnetha and Frida, who will be coming to school each day. These two cuties need to be bottle fed twice a day to help them grow big and strong. Just another reason for kids to



look forward to art this term. Mr Jarman is very proud of his little lambs.

Last week saw the return of Grades 3 to 6 students in schools across Victoria, joining the younger children who started back at schools two weeks prior. Our students did not disappoint and they have returned and settled back in without a hiccup. It is very nice to have all of our students back on site. It is also worth acknowledging how well most of our students adapted to and coped with remote learning, some even thrived. The majority of our students showed great commitment to their learning and resilience when things didn't go well. All students from Grades 4 to 6 will complete a short survey on remote learning before the end of term. I have had a quick look at the results and there are some really positive responses and comments so far. However, the most common positive reflection on learning from home from our students was that "you could eat whenever you wanted."

Key to the success of our remote and flexible learning was the support of our parents and carers. On behalf of all of the staff at RHCS, I would like to thank you all for the support and encouragement you showed your children during this period. I know for many of us, this was a challenging time and juggling careers, house work, younger siblings and learning from home was a tough balancing act. I would also like to clarify, that RHCS is supported by and supports our local businesses and encourages our parent community to do the same. One area that still requires a little improvement is our bus service. We are still holding the bus up for students who have not had their permanent schedule updated or have not completed a bus note for the day. This is instrumental to the smooth running of our bus service. Can I also please remind you that yourself or another adult must meet your child/ren at the bus stop each evening. By all working together we can hopefully return to a more consistent time of departure in the afternoons.



This week the Somers Camp Road Show came to RHCS as part of our planning week. We are very grateful for the support provided to us by the staff at Somers Camp, who also supervised our students who attended onsite during remote and flexible learning. This time, the Somers Camp teachers worked with our Grade 3 and 6 students, running bush camping, orienteering and drama activities. The kids all had a great time learning new skills in the outdoors.

Speaking of camps, you may have heard the announcement that camps and excursions are back on for Term 3 and 4 in Victorian Schools. No advice regarding this has been received from the Department as yet. However, we will be following all DET guidelines and will be working closely with our providers in the coming weeks to formulate a plan. We will communicate any news regarding camps and excursions as soon as it becomes available.

Garden Centre

A big thank you to the wonderful team of Education Support Staff who gave our Garden Centre a winter clean up on last Friday's student free day. The weeds and vines had returned over the learning from home period, but our team of green thumbs worked hard to get it back under control, ready to plant a winter harvest. The amazing Ms Green is organising seedlings and coordinating our teachers to get this underutilised area of the school back in action.
